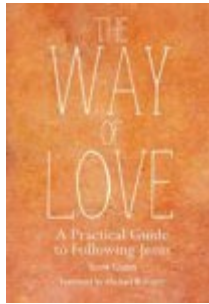

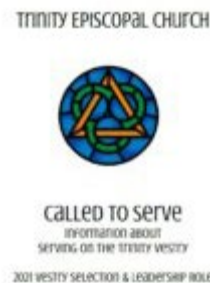
## September COVID-19 Update

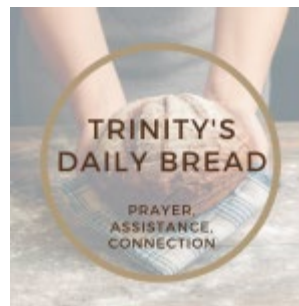
