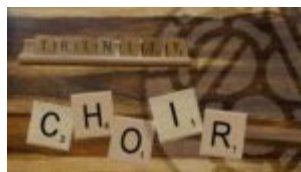
Virtual Book Club: Sunday, 2/28 at 6:30PM

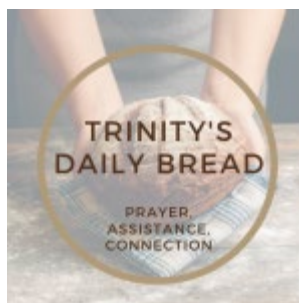
