





still available in the Trinity office.


### **Pop Up Dinners**

#### Celtic Retreat at Bellwether Farm

Bellwether Farm will host a Celtic retreat, "Exploring our Anglican Roots through Celtic Spirituality," on August 2-4. The retreat will venture into Celtic spirituality and the experience of God in all creation and how the life of the Celtic peoples became the roots of Anglican spirituality. We will explore Celtic prayer and Soul Friendship and close by looking for the next step of our journeys through the Celtic idea of Peregrinatio.
