welcome!

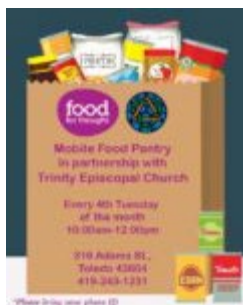
## TSN Vendor Lunch Team

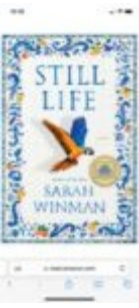
