### Welcome Interim Rector Stephen Applegate



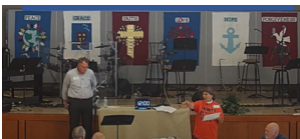

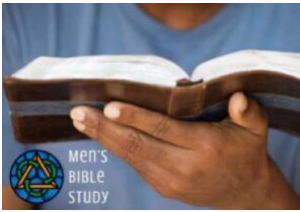
### Nova Ensemble Choral Performance
