### opening statement

Celebrant: Alleluia! Christ is risen!

**People:** Christ is risen indeed! Alleluia! Celebrant: There is one Body and one Spirit;

**People:** There is one hope in God's call to us;

Celebrant: One God, one Faith, one Baptism;

**People:** One God and Creator of all.

#### Presentation and Examination of the Candidate

Celebrant: The Candidate for Holy Baptism will now be presented.

The candidate who is able to answer for himself is presented as follows:

Sponsor: I present Oliver Rose to receive the Sacrament of Baptism.

Celebrant: Do you desire to be baptized?

Candidate: I do.

Then the Celebrant asks the following questions of the candidate.

Question: Do you renounce Satan and all the spiritual forces of wickedness that rebel against God?

Answer: I renounce them.

Question: Do you renounce the evil powers of this world

which corrupt and destroy the creatures of God?

Answer: I renounce them.

Question: Do you renounce all sinful desires that draw you from the love of God?

Answer: I renounce them.

Question: Do you turn to Jesus and accept him as your Savior?

Answer: I do.

Question: Do you put your whole trust in Christ's grace and love?

Answer: I do.

Question: Do you promise to follow and obey Christ as your Savior?

Answer: I do.

The Celebrant then addresses the congregation, saying:

Will you who witness these vows do all in your power to support him in his life in Christ?

People: We will.

The Celebrant then says these or similar words:

Let us join with Oliver who is committing himself to Christ and renew our own baptismal covenant.

THE BAPTISMAL COVENANT

Celebrant: Do you believe in God the Father?

creator of heaven and earth.

Celebrant: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit

and born of the Virgin Mary.

He suffered under Pontius Pilate,
was crucified, died, and was buried.

He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again.

He ascended into heaven,

and is seated at the right hand of the Father.

He will come again to judge the living and the dead.

Celebrant: Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?

People: I believe in the Holy Spirit,

the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins,

the resurrection of the body,

and the life everlasting.

Celebrant: Will you continue in the apostles' teaching and fellowship, in the breaking of

bread, and in the prayers?

People: I will, with God's help.

Celebrant: Will you persevere in resisting evil, and, whenever you fall into sin, repent and

return to the Lord?

People: I will, with God's help.

Celebrant: Will you proclaim by word and example the Good News of God in Christ?

People: I will, with God's help.

Celebrant: Will you seek and serve Christ in all persons, loving your neighbor as yourself?

People: I will, with God's help.

Celebrant: Will you strive for justice and peace among all people, and respect the dignity of

every human being?

People: I will, with God's help.

### THANKSGIVING OVER THE WATER

The Celebrant blesses the water, first saying:

Celebrant: God be with you.

People: And also with you.

Celebrant: Let us give thanks to God.

People: It is right to give our thanks and praise.

Celebrant: We thank you, Almighty God, for the gift of water. Over it the Holy Spirit moved in

the beginning of creation. Through it you led the children of Israel out of their bondage in Egypt into the land of promise. In it your Son Jesus received the baptism of John and was anointed by the Holy Spirit as the Messiah, the Christ, to lead us, through his death and resurrection, from the bondage of sin into

everlasting life. We thank you, for the water of Baptism. In it we are buried with Christ in his death. By it we share in the resurrection. Through it we are reborn by the Holy Spirit. Therefore in joyful obedience to your Son, we bring into this fellowship those who come in faith, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and

of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

At the following words, the Celebrant touches the water

Now sanctify this water, we pray you, by the power of your Holy Spirit, that those who here are cleansed from sin and born again may continue for ever in the risen life of Jesus Christ our Savior.

To him, to you, and to the Holy Spirit, be all honor and glory, now and for ever. **Amen.** 

### THE BAPTISM

Celebrant: Oliver, I baptize you in the Name of the Father, and of the Son,

and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Then the Priest places a hand on Oliver's head, marking on the forehead the sign of the cross using Chrism and saying to him:

Celebrant: Oliver, you are sealed by the Holy Spirit in Baptism and marked as Christ's own for

ever. Amen.

When this action has been completed, the Priest, at a place in full sight of the congregation, prays over him, saying:

Celebrant: Let us pray.

God of Love, we thank you that by water and the Holy Spirit you have bestowed upon this your servant the forgiveness of sin, and have raised him to the new life of grace. Sustain him, O Lord, in your Holy Spirit. Give him an inquiring and discerning heart, the courage to will and to persevere, a spirit to know and to love you, and the gift of joy and wonder in all your works. Amen.

Celebrant: Let us welcome the newly baptized.

People: We receive you into the household of God. Confess the faith of Christ crucified,

proclaim the resurrection, and share with us in the eternal priesthood.

All may applaud! Members of the congregation return to their seats.

THE SECOND LESSON HEBREWS 11:29-12:2

*Reader:* A reading from the letter to the Hebrews.

By faith the people passed through the Red Sea as if it were dry land, but when the Egyptians attempted to do so they were drowned. By faith the walls of Jericho fell after they had been encircled for seven days. By faith Rahab the prostitute did not perish with those who were disobedient, because she had received the spies in peace.

And what more should I say? For time would fail me to tell of Gideon, Barak, Samson, Jephthah, of David and Samuel and the prophets— who through faith conquered kingdoms, administered justice, obtained promises, shut the mouths of lions, quenched raging fire, escaped the edge of the sword, won strength out of weakness, became mighty in war, put foreign armies to flight. Women received their dead by resurrection. Others were tortured, refusing to accept release, in order to obtain a better resurrection. Others suffered mocking and flogging, and even chains and imprisonment. They were stoned to death, they were sawn in two, they were killed by the sword; they went about in skins of sheep and goats, destitute, persecuted, tormented— of whom the world was not worthy. They wandered in deserts and mountains, and in caves and holes in the ground.

Yet all these, though they were commended for their faith, did not receive what was promised, since God had provided something better so that they would not, apart from us, be made perfect.

Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight and the sin that clings so closely, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus the pioneer and perfecter of our faith, who for the sake of the joy that was set before him endured the cross, disregarding its shame, and has taken his seat at the right hand of the throne of God.

Presider: God be with you.

Presider: Lift up your hearts.


People: We lift them to God.

Presider: Let us give thanks to Christ our God.

**People:** It is right to give our thanks and praise.

All thanks and praise are yours at all times and in all places, our true and loving God; through Jesus Christ, your eternal Word, the Wisdom from on high by whom you created all things. You laid the foundations of the world and enclosed the sea when it burst out from the womb; You brought forth all creatures of the earth and gave breath to humankind.

Wondrous are you, Holy One of Blessing, all you create is a sign of hope for our journey; And so as the morning stars sing your praises we join the heavenly beings and all creation as we shout with joy:



And it is with the power of Christ that we proclaim that this table is open to all people — no matter who you are or what you believe or what you've been told. Here at Christ's table we remember the simple gathering of a chosen family that came together for a meal that proclaimed a new way of being in this world.

We remember God's radically inclusive love made real in the life, ministry, death, and resurrection of Jesus. We remember the One who befriended the forgotten, embraced the outcast, and saw the Image of God in all people. We remember the One who confronted every power that disconnected, marginalized, oppressed, and "other-ed."

It is here at this table that we find hope and imagination to see God's dream and promise of a world of wholeness, and it is here that we receive the nourishment and strength to continue on the paths of justice.

We recall that on the night he was betrayed, Jesus took a loaf of bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body that is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

In the same way he took the cup, saying, "This is my blood, my very life, poured out for you. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me."

God, we thank you for breathing this world into existence and proclaiming from its birth: "It is good." Breathe the breath of your Spirit on us and upon these gifts of bread and wine, that they may be for us the Body and Blood of our Savior Jesus Christ. We come to you with gratitude for the endless blessings that we see, feel, and know on our journeys of life. We celebrate the rich diversity of your creation — every beautiful body, every shade of skin, every expression of love.

Through your Spirit, open our hearts to the joy we can find in the midst of life's challenges. Remind us that we are loved — fiercely and forever. And however the world may try to hold us down or tell us who to be, remind us that nothing can separate us from your presence.

And deliver us from evil.


